## The rules regarding Fruit trees

- Only fruit trees are allowed on Cripley Meadow plots. If there are other trees on your plot they must/will be removed.
- Fruit trees must be on dwarf or semi dwarf stock
- They must be kept under the 10' maximum ht.
- The root and shade fall, which is roughly the same as the branch spread, must be kept within your plot boundary.
- To use this maximum size most members would have to plant the tree at least 5ft away from boundary and also consider any potential shading of adjacent plots.
- Fruit trees must not overhang/obstruct paths
- Members must obtain written permission from the committee before planting.

## The rules regarding sheds

- Members must get the Committee's written approval of size, materials and siting of sheds or greenhouses before starting.
- Members are advised that sheds should be approx 6x8x8 and should be built on shed lines. No buildings can shade / impair adjacent plots. Half plots can only have tool stores/boxes if they do not occupy the half on the shed line. Tool stores must not shade / impair adjacent plots.

## The rules regarding fences/paths

- Adjoining pathways must be kept tended to a width of 2ft (60cm).
- Members must keep any hedges trimmed, and sheds, greenhouses, fences (max ht 5') gates etc. in safe repair.
- Fences should be of post and chicken wire to a max height of 5'. Existing higher fences must be lowered or removed.
- Barbed wire must not be used anywhere on the site.
