### **Manure**

We had the last delivery to Plot 57 during May so now had 4 lots

### **Skip**

We removed a skip last week and there is now another one. Please do not over fill and only use for site rubbish that cannot be burnt or recycled. Remember, 'recycling' does not mean that you can use your plot as a dump/store.

**Buildbase** We had the delivery of free wooden pallets and they have all been used. I will try get more another time. They were stored by the association shed.

### **Follow up to Badgers and other pests**

As you know we have been consulting Natural England and we know at least one member is trying out electric fencing

around a bed. We will let you know if it works and sweetcorn is saved.

We have published this information frequently in newsletters and annual reports. All hedges, have been audited on this basis for 3 years now. We have offered to have a some bamboo on the green where we feel we can manage it by our mowing regime and it will be accessible and available to all without detriment to the site.

### **Willows**

Please note that willows must not be planted, even as hedges. If willow sticks are used for dry hedges on headlands they must be bark stripped or kept out of the ground as otherwise they will grow. Please note all hedges and boundary planting are confined to 5ft on headlands i.e. next to public paths. There should be no hedges or solid fences **on adjoining fences.** We all need to work together to sustain good growing conditions for all and for the future.
