DRESS FOR THE OCCASION

- appropriate shoes or boots
- gloves – preferably leather or with rubberised palms

BEWARE DANGEROUS ITEMS

- if you come across anything you are unsure about, do not touch it – report it to your organiser
- particular items to watch out for are needles, syringes,
- unidentifiable drums, cans/canisters of chemicals, poisons or insecticides
- do not pick up items that are too bulky/heavy and leave flytipping where it is – report it to your organiser
- do not put glass bottles/jars or sharp objects in plastic sacks –your organiser will have a green box for it

KEEP IN CONTACT

- Make sure you know how to get in touch with your organiser in case you need to report dangerous items or for any other reasons
- Take a mobile phone with you if you can
